

Chief Safety Officer would like to have your attention..

Dear spectator, please act responsibly.

Competitors wish to stay on the road but unfortunately that doesn't always happen.

The speed of the race car can be as high as 200 km/h and in case of an accident the car can travel quite far from the road and in an unexpected direction. When choosing your location on the special stages please bear in mind your own safety as well as others.

- moving on the road on foot or with a vehicle during the special stages is prohibited
- keep your distance from the road
- landing places, outer curves and crossings are all dangerous places for spectators
- prioritize higher ground in relation to the road and inner curves
- plan an escape route in advance. It is hard to escape quickly when sitting down or in deep snow
- take special care of children
- competitors are advancing on the special stages in uneven intervals
- stay on spectating areas recommended by the organiser
- when parking, make sure you leave space to drive past your car. Park on the right side of the road.
- in case of an accident, do not run to the car before you are sure that the following car is not approaching
- do not attempt to move a race car before the crew has given permission to do so
- do not show the SOS sign without consideration. It is to be used only in case the Special Stage start or competition emergency number cannot be reached by phone (phone number can be found on the sticker next to the competition number on the side of the car)
- Show the SOS sign if a fire extinguisher or help from the next crew is required
- The officials on the special stage are obliged to make sure that their area remains safe. As a responsible spectator you will assist the officials if needed or if they request it.

Drones

- The video rights of The Finnish Rally Championship are reserved to AKK Sports Oy
- You need a licence to filming using a drone, make sure you have the appropriate licence
- filming with a drone on the road on special stages and above spectators is not allowed due to safety reasons

Media

- Dangerous spectating areas are prohibited from everyone, including media representatives
- Photographers with authorised media tabards cannot film in prohibited spectating areas and plead to freedom of responsibility
